Animals at School:

EIPS Administrative Procedure 255

Animals are not permitted at Division-owned, leased or rented school buildings, grounds or worksites. Exceptions may be given for service dogs, educational assistance animals and animals serving a specific educational purpose such as pet therapy, participation in pet days, short-term educational projects or social events. **Please do not bring your dogs on school grounds.**

Learning Commons:

All students in Grades 3-6 have received instruction on how to request books in Destiny and place holds. Once a student places a hold on a book, Ms. Wells-Taylor

will deliver the book to their classroom. Students are able to take library books home to read, but once returned to school, the books will be placed into quarantine for 72 hours per EIPS Covid Guidelines.

Students in K-2 will have the chance to take out books selected from a cart delivered to their classrooms during a specific library time. However, if you would like to place books on hold at home with your child through Destiny, please follow the instructions below. As in the upper grades, these books will be delivered to your child's classroom.

Logging onto Destiny.

- 1. Go to <u>destiny.eips.ca</u>, select Heritage Hills Elementary
- 2. In top right corner, click Log In. Students log in using their Google e-mail account.
- 3. Search for books and place a hold.
- 4. Wait for Ms. Wells-Taylor to deliver your book.

Please note, students are only allowed to place 2 books on hold at a time. Holds expire after 2 weeks, if a book does not become available during the 2 week period, they will have to place a hold again.
