We are experiencing a number of students who do not have enough masks to make it through the school day. Please send 3 masks to school with your child for every school day (1 to wear and 2 spare). With the current weather, masks often feel wet after an outdoor recess and students will often ask to change their mask.

Carnaval:

Thank you for the planning time spent by the committee. We selected February 7 - 25 as our 3 weeks for Carnaval. We will have weekly slideshows with activities. Most activities are asynchronous and can be done at teacher discretion. We are going to add some treats "cornet de tire d'érable", a special hot lunch (tortière and tarte au sucre) Feb. 16 & 18 and a special 1/2 day of activities and games dates TBD. Bonhomme will most certainly be making some guest appearances.
