
Bus Loop: Families are welcome to use both the student drop off loop and the bus lanes on cold days when the buses are NOT running or during evening events. But, during regular school days when buses are running, NO vehicles are permitted to enter the bus loop or do u-turns at either entrance and pedestrians should never be walking across that space.

As the weather has become colder we have had many more families using the bus loop in the morning, which is not permitted. When you are dropping off your children please use the student drop off area; drop them off and move on. If you need to go into the school or park for a few minutes please use visitor parking or park on the road in front of the school. Once we have a traffic jam it becomes unsafe for our students.

Kindergarten Registration Starts Soon!

Is your child turning five on or before Dec. 31, 2024? If so, it's almost time to register for kindergarten.

Kindergarten registration opens for the 2024-25 school year at 9 a.m. on Feb. 1, 2024.

To help families prepare, Elk Island Public Schools has put together an online **<u>EIPS</u>** <u>**Kindergarten Tool kit**</u> to make the transition as smooth as possible. The kit includes information on registration, important dates, programming options, what to expect, eligibility, how to find your designated school, transportation and more.

Returning Student Registration: 2024-25:

Elk Island Public Schools (EIPS) will once again conduct an online returning student registration process to confirm student registrations for the 2024-25 school year. Families of all current students—with the exception of graduating Grade 12 students—must complete the process to confirm the school their child plans to attend in the 2024-25 school year or advise the Division of their plans not to return to EIPS. Additionally, students who want to attend a non-designated school need to make that request through the returning student registration process—acceptance is based on available space. The 2024-25 returning student registration takes place Feb. 8-21, 2024.

One contact for each current PALS to Grade 11 student will receive the Returning Student Registration Form link through Permission Click on February 8. The recipient is based on which contact has been identified as the one to receive forms as listed on the most recent registration form, Correction and Verification Form or Student Information Update submitted to the Division. To review the contacts listed for each student, refer to the Student Information Update available through the **PowerSchool Parent Portal**. Only one contact can be selected to receive forms.


