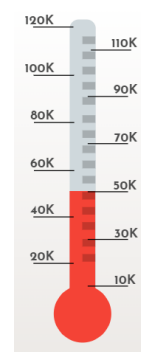

We have reached this total with the support of our hot lunch and treat days, using our casino revenue from last year, as well as budgeted items that have had the cost covered by the school (Christmas concert, Carnival activities and staff Christmas lunch to name a few). We are hoping to reach a goal of at least \$120,000. To help reach this goal we will be applying for a provincial matching grant in the spring so every dollar we raise until then counts!
